The Rock Lookout	You must visit The Rock Lookout while in Penrith Valley! Come and look out over the majestic Nepean Gorge and its surrounds. The view is simply breath taking. Lookout is short walk from car park.	Turn right into Fairlight Rd from Mulgoa Rd (traveling south from Penrith). Please note: The last 3kms of Fairlight Rd is unsealed.
Riley's Mountain Lookout	Follow the fire trail from the Rock Lookout car park to Riley's Mountain Lookout through heath and eucalypt forest. Experience more views of the Nepean Gorge and its surrounds. For the keen walker or photographer	Fairlight Rd, then walk 40mins from the Rock Lookout on the marked fire trail.
St Thomas Anglican Church and Cemetery	This golden sandstone church was consecrated on 13/9/1838 by Australia's first Anglican Bishop, William Broughton. The gate is open Sundays for 10.30am service or most Tuesdays between 10am and 1pm	St Thomas Rd, Mulgoa
