



Retail Therapy Part of a Leisurely Lifestyle

No push-and-shove, no trolley rage, no parking hassles. Shopping at Penrith is regarded as retail therapy. Major shopping centres, busy main-street trading and lively markets make shopping part of the fabric of the district's attractive lifestyle.

Penrith Plaza – the biggest of the centres makes purchasing daily necessities a pleasure. Its list of retailers includes leading chains such as Woolworths, Franklins, Myer, Big W and Target. There are major banks, an international food court and a fast food market, a 10-screen cinema complex and speciality stores offering everything from manchester to movie memorabilia and perfumes to portrait photography. The Plaza is open seven days a week and is located right across the road from Penrith Railway Station.

St Mary's Village Centre on Charles Hackett Drive St Mary's, Centro Nepean on Station Street Penrith, and Lennox Centre on the Great Western Highway Emu Plains are other major shopping centres in the district.

Penrith Valley is also noted for the popularity of its markets. Largest of these is the Penrith Showground Markets each Wednesday which attracts around 300 stallholders and thousands of regular bargain hunters buying produce, plants, crafts and bric-a-brac at big savings. Market hours are 7:30m to 1:30pm.
